There will be two (2) Arts & Crafts Packets this year. Packet 1 is for those Daughters attending Supreme Session in person and Packet 2 will be for those Daughters who will attend Supreme Session Hybrid. This is Packet 1.

Those Daughters attending in person cannot bring items for Arts & Crafts Competitions for other Daughters who are not attending in person. Those not attending in person will register their Arts and Crafts Competitions Hybrid (Packet 2). Each packet has its own rules.

2024 Supreme Arts & Crafts General Rules

Please read the general rules for the competition as well as the specific guidelines for each category. If you have any questions, please contact Kathy Summers, Chairman, by either phone or by email.

The Daughter's age as of July 21, 2024, determines which age group the Daughter should enter, Jobie-to-Bees may enter all categories.

Arts & Crafts categories will be judged under the specific age groups as follows:

- Δ J2B: 7-9 years old
- Δ 10-12 years old
- Δ 13-15 years old
- Δ 16-17 years old
- Δ 18-19 years old

Additional breakdowns may be added based on registration.

Exception: The Promotion Category will NOT be broken down into age groups.

FINAL REGISTRATION FOR ALL ENTRIES IS JUNE 1, 2024.

QUALIFICATIONS: Job's Daughters submitting entries must be in good standing with JDI as of July 21, 2024. The contestant must have made the entry during the current Supreme Guardian Council year. August 2023 through July 2024.

ENTRIES: How to enter Arts & Crafts items for judging

Registered entries need to be hand-delivered to the Arts & Crafts room at Supreme. Hand delivered entries are to be submitted at the Courtyard by Marriott La Vista Hotel & Conference Center La Vista, Nebraska starting on Monday, July 22 between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm, but no later than Tuesday, July 23, between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm. Please check the actual Session information at the hotel for any adjustments to entry times. No late entries will be accepted unless caused by a travel emergency.

Additional Info.

*A contestant may enter only 1 (one) item per Division. The contestant must be registered as IN-PERSON at Supreme Session to enter. We will not accept multiple entries under the same division from daughters.

*The name of the person responsible for picking up the entry must be clearly stated.

*The entry must be as described on the registration form; substitutions will not be accepted.

*Contestants are responsible for storing their own packing material. Packing material left in the competition room will be discarded.

PREPARE ENTRIES: A sealed envelope must be attached to each entry with the following information listed on the **outside** of the envelope:

- Daughters Age
- Category

The **inside** of the envelope must contain a copy of the registration form.

CATEGORIES:

Each contestant determines which division and category she wishes her entry to be judged. However, the Arts and Crafts Committee reserves the right to adjust categories. Please read the rules and guidelines for each category. The Supreme Arts and Crafts Committee reserves the right to disqualify an entry at its discretion based on content in keeping with the rules and regulations of Job's Daughters International.

JUDGING:

Judging will be Wednesday, July 24, from 9:00 am - 5:00 pm No viewing of entries will be allowed before or during the judging. Judging will be based on the following, as applicable: originality, design, artistry, presentation/layout, degree of difficulty, craftsmanship, neatness and finishing.

Completed judging score sheets will be given to the contestants after the Awards Luncheon on Friday. The decision of the judges is

final.

VIEWING: The competition room will be open for viewing Thursday, July 25th

from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm and Friday, July 26th from 9am to 11am. All entries must remain in the competition room during this time.

PICK-UP: Entries must be claimed from the committee on Friday, July 26th

between 1:30 pm and 4:00 pm unless other arrangements have

been made with the Arts and Crafts Committee Chairman.

- May not mention the Daughter's name or Bethel number.
- Entry may not have been previously submitted to a Supreme Arts & Crafts contest.
- Only one (1) entry per Daughter.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.

- Must not contain any reference to a Daughter's name or Bethel number.
- A summary and a link will be in the Book of Writings-must have parent/s signature to be included.
- Entry may not have been previously submitted to a Supreme Arts & Crafts contest.
- Only one (1) entry per Daughter.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.

- A brief summary and a link will be in the Book of Writings must have parent/s signature to be included.
- Entry may not have been previously submitted to a Supreme Arts & Crafts contest.
- Only one (1) entry per Daughter.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.

- Only one (1) entry per Daughter or Bethel.

- Only one (1) entry per Daughter.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.

- Only one (1) entry per Daughter per category.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.

PHOTOGRAPHY CATEGORIES

Category 1: Portrait

A photograph of a person. One depicting only the face and /or head and shoulders.

Category 2: Still Life

A photograph of an arrangement of objects, typically including fruit and/or flowers and objects contrasting with these in texture, such as bowls and glassware.

Category 3: Candid Shot

The definition of candid is informal or natural (any subject).

Category 4: Scenery

A picturesque view or landscape.

Category 5: Other

Any photo that doesn't fit in the other 4 categories.

Division H – Painting
Category 1: Oil or Acrylic

Category Rules

- Must be an original painting created entirely by the Daughter submitting the entry.
- Please limit the size to no larger than 16x24 inches.
- Must mention on the entry form the medium used to create the painting (i.e. oil, watercolor, acrylic, or mixed media).
- Must not contain any reference to a Daughter's name or Bethel number.
- Entry may not have been previously submitted to a Supreme Arts & Crafts contest.
- Only one (1) entry per Daughter per category.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.

- Please limit the size to no larger than 16x24 inches.
- Should be either matted and/or framed or have a sturdy adhered backing.
- Must not contain any reference to a Daughter's name or Bethel number.
- Entry may not have been previously submitted to a Supreme Arts & Crafts contest.
- Only one (1) entry per Daughter.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.

- Must not contain any reference to a Daughter's name or Bethel number.
- Entry may not have been previously submitted to a Supreme Arts & Crafts contest.
- Only one (1) entry per Daughter.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.

- Only one (1) entry per Daughter.
- Daughter's name should not appear on the entry itself.
