<p>Registration</p>	<p>Competition will be held Tuesday, August 3, 2021 at the Embassy Suites. All participants MUST BE registered for Session..</p> <p>Registration will be available online at: https://bit.ly/supremecompetitions</p> <p>Each participant will be notified by email the time of their competition. A schedule will be posted near session registration.</p> <p><u>Daughters or Jurisdictional Messenger Teams, may only participate in person at Supreme Session or Virtually - they may NOT participate in both.</u></p> <p>All Competitors must check in personally the day of competition at least 15 minutes before your scheduled competition time.</p> <p>ALL ENTRIES ARE DUE BY JUNE 1st, 2021</p> <p>There will be NO spectators allowed in competition rooms.</p>
<p>Qualifications</p>	<p>A Daughter must NOT have reached her 21st birthday on or before August 4, 2021.</p> <p>Daughters may enter only one INDIVIDUAL category.</p> <p>Grand Guardian Councils (GGC) – A GGC can submit one Messenger Team. In GGCs where you have more than 10 (ten) Bethels one team per area may compete. If more than one team per GGC competes, team members must be from the same area.</p> <p>Jurisdictional Councils (JGC) – A JGCs can submit one Messenger Team.</p> <p>Bethels Under Supreme (BUS) – BUS can submit one Messenger Team per Bethel. If a Bethel does not have enough Daughters to form a team they may combine with other BUS.</p>
<p>Minimum Scores</p>	<p>All contestants must achieve a minimum score of 90% for 1st place, 85% for 2nd place, and 75% for 3rd place.</p>
<p>Age Categories</p>	<p>Age is based on date of Competition</p> <p>Age categories will be determined based upon the amount of registrations. Majority Member Team: No Age Restriction</p>
<p>Robe Judging</p>	<p><u>All in-person competitors must compete in proper regalia, if available. If official regalia is unavailable a Daughter must be in Jobie appropriate dress or skirt/blouse.</u></p> <p>Robes will be judged based on the following: Floor Officers (Messenger and Chaplain) – robe should be clean, pressed, cords placed correctly with 3-6 inch yoke in front, 3 inches off the floor with a 4 inch hem. White shoes/slippers, white hose and a long slip (below the knee). White and Purple headband. (Continued) HQ and Princess' – robe should be clean, pressed, 3 inches off the floor with a hem depth of 4 inches. White shoes/slippers, white hose and a long slip (below the knee). Cape and Crown – no hair will be covering the crown band as per ritual.</p>

	IMPORTANT NOTE: Daughters competing in Messenger Team, Story of Job will wear white robe with cords. Daughters competing in individual HQ or JR/SR Princess AND Messenger Team will need to have robe judged with “Floor Officer Regalia” and with “Royalty Regalia”.
Jewelry & Nail Polish	Due to the many variations amongst Countries and Jurisdictions we ask that <u>NO Jewelry or Nail Polish be worn.</u>

Individual Categories: Will give all initiatory work and **NOT** include Station and Duty and **WILL** give instructions to Guide and Marshal, HQ or any others.

Team Categories: Messenger Teams will **NOT** include Station and Duty. Team members **WILL** give all instructions to the Guide and Marshal.

Story of Job: Will give all initiatory work and will **NOT** include Station and Duty and will **NOT** give instructions to the Guide and Marshal.

All Categories:

- Pay attention to floor work, hand positions, sitting, as per instructions in Ritual.
- The Daughter may enter and leave the competition room in any manner she chooses.
- Before entering the competition room, the door monitor will give the competitor(s) information regarding prompting and any other instructions. The Competitor(s) may ask questions at this time.

Messengers	Rise. Take position and present initiatory work, as per Ritual, with instructions to Guide and Marshal. Return to station as per Ritual and be seated signifying the completion of the competition.
Chaplain	Rise, approach Altar and open the Bible, give pledge of honor. Remain at Altar for the Opening Prayer (NOT the Lord’s Prayer), Obligation (with the introductory preface), initiation closing prayer, and meeting closing prayer. Kneeling and rising as specified. At conclusion of Closing Prayer rise and close Bible. Return to station and be seated signifying completion of competition. Review Proficiency #1
JR Princess	Rise. Will give the sign and response of the First Epoch. Give initiatory work per Ritual. (Note: when being examined by the Senior Princess you will not be given assistance.) Be seated at the close of the initiatory work signifying the completion of your part. Proficiency Lessons #2-7
SR Princess	Rise. Will give the sign and response of the Second Epoch. Give initiatory work per Ritual. (Note: when examining the Junior Princess you will not be given responses.) Be seated at the close of the initiatory work signifying the completion of your part. Proficiency Lesson #4, 5, 8
Honored Queen	Rise. Begin with opening statement “The officers will take their stations.” Continue with National Emblem and Bethel Flag Presentations, rap gavel as indicated, Pledge of Honor for adults, Stations and Duties of Officers (including instructions to the Guards and naming all stations per ritual). Pause after saying station and duty then recite “The sign of the 3rd epoch...” Call the Chaplain to lead in the Opening Prayer and open the Bethel. Give initiation work, as per Ritual. Give the closing ceremony. Be seated to signify the completion of your part. Proficiency Lesson #6, 7, 9.

<p>Story of Job</p>	<p>Begin seated in the 1st Messenger's chair, approach the altar and recite all 5 initiatory lectures in succession and upon completion be seated in the 5th Messenger Chair. NO INSTRUCTIONS TO THE GUIDE AND MARSHAL SHALL BE GIVEN.</p>
<p>Daughter and Majority Messenger Teams</p>	<p>Teams will enter, assume their respective stations and be seated. The team will be told they may begin and the Messengers will, in turn, approach the Altar, as per Ritual, give initiatory work in succession and be seated. Competition will conclude when the 5th Messenger returns to her seat and is seated. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE GUIDE AND MARSHAL SHALL BE GIVEN</p>
<p>Jobie-to-Be</p>	<p>The Jobie-to-Be will enter the room, stand behind the Altar and recite an excerpt from a prayer written by Mother Mick. She will be excused upon completion of the prayer. Jobie-to-Be is NOT to assume the Attitude of Prayer.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> Heavenly Father, we have followed Thee Throughout this changeable year Kindly progress, light on our pathway Bringing comfort with cheer.
