Registration	Virtual Ritual Competition will be held the weekend of July 15-17 2022 via Zoom. All participants <b>MUST</b> register as a remote attendee or with a competition pass to participate.

	Each participant will be notified by email the date, time and the Zoom link for their competition.
	Individual Daughters and Jurisdictional Messenger Teams may only participate in-person at Supreme Session OR Virtually - they may NOT participate in both.
	ALL ENTRIES ARE DUE BY:
	June 1, 2022, MIDNIGHT Eastern Standard time.
	A Daughter must NOT have reached her 20th birthday on or before July 26, 2022.
Qualifications	Daughters may enter only one INDIVIDUAL category.
	Grand Guardian Councils (GGC) – A GGC can submit one Messenger Team.
	Jurisdictional Councils (JGC) – A JGCs can submit one Messenger Team.
	Bethels Under Supreme (BUS) –
	BUS can submit one Messenger Team per Bethel. If a Bethel does not have enough Daughters to form a team they may combine with other BUS.
Minimum Scores	All contestants must achieve a minimum score of 90% for 1st place, 85% for 2nd place, and 75% for 3rd place.
Age Categories	Age is based on date of Competition
	10-12 years old 13-15 years old 16-17 years old 18-20 years old



Individual Categories: WILL give all initiatory work and instructions to Guide, Marshal,

HQ or any others.

They WILL NOT include Station and Duty.

**Team Categories:** Team members **WILL** give all instructions to the Guide and Marshal.

Messenger Teams WILL NOT include Station and Duty.

Story of Job: WILL give all initiatory work.

They WILL NOT include Station and Duty and

**WILL NOT** give instructions to the Guide and Marshal.

## **All Categories:**

• Upon entering the Zoom competition room, a Judge will give the competitor(s) information regarding prompting and any other instructions. The Competitor(s) may ask questions at this time.

- All competitors shall wear official regalia if available, otherwise all clothing in keeping with the ideals of JDI.
- Competitors shall be in a location where they are able to stand and be viewed from head to waist with a still camera.

Messengers	While standing will give the initiation lecture. INSTRUCTIONS TO GUIDE AND MARSHAL SHALL BE GIVEN.
Chaplain	While standing will give the pledge of honor, the Opening Prayer (NOT the Lord's Prayer)., Obligation with the introductory preface, initiation closing prayer, and conclude by reciting the Closing Prayer. All parts should be given in succession.  Review Proficiency Lesson #1
Story of Job	While standing recite all initiatory lectures in succession. NO INSTRUCTIONS TO THE GUIDE AND MARSHAL SHALL BE GIVEN.
Daughter Teams	The team will be told they may begin and the Messengers will, in turn, recite the initiatory work. Individual Messengers will not be prompted to begin, and shall proceed in succession. Competition will conclude when 5 <sup>th</sup> Messenger completes her lecture.  INSTRUCTIONS TO THE GUIDE AND MARSHAL SHALL BE GIVEN.
