Jingle Entry Requirements:

- Each Bethel may submit one entry.
- The Jingle must be between 60-90 seconds long.

- Lyrics must be original and created by Bethel members.
- The Jingle may be performed a cappella or with instrumental background.
- The Jingle must be submitted as:
- Written lyrics (typed, PDF or Word)
- Video recording (MP4 or YouTube unlisted link)
- Language: Any language used in your country/province is welcome. Please supply sub titles and a translated script if not in English.
- Creativity: Jingles should be catchy, easy to remember, and reflect JDI values and not contain any lyrics or music that is not original.
- Deadline: Submissions due 1st June 2026.
- Ownership: By entering, Bethels grant JDI permission to use the jingle for promotional purposes and agree not to publicly post their entries until after Supreme Session 2026.
