Section 16. Jobie to Bee Program Committee

- (a) The Committee shall be composed of:
 - (1) The Supreme Beekeeper (See B-SGC Art. V, Sec. 2);
 - (2) All Assistant Supreme Beekeepers;
 - (3) One (1) or two (2) continuing members who shall serve as Project Managers and shall not be subject to committee rotation; and
 - (4) Such additional members as recommended by the Supreme Line and approved by the Supreme Guardian.
- (b) The Supreme Beekeeper shall serve as Chairman of the Committee and shall perform the duties outlined in B-SGC Art. V, Sec. 2 in coordination with this Committee.
- (c) The Project Managers shall serve as continuing members to ensure continuity, consistency, and forward momentum in the development, administration, and expansion of the Jobie to Bee Program.
- (d) The duties of this Committee are as follows:
 - (1) Support and assist the Supreme Beekeeper in fulfilling the responsibilities set forth in B-SGC Art. V, Sec. 2.
 - (2) Create, publish, and maintain an official Beehive Handbook for use by all Bee Programs throughout Job's Daughters International.
 - (3) Collaborate with all relevant committees of the SGC, GGCs, JGCs, and Bethels under Supreme to develop, strengthen, and expand the Bee Program in all jurisdictions of Job's Daughters International.
 - (4) Oversee and administer all Bee-related awards, recognitions, and initiatives of Job's Daughters International.
 - (5) Develop guidelines, resources, and best practices to ensure consistent and sustainable implementation of the Bee Program.
 - (6) Foster, promote, and encourage the implementation of the Bee Program in every Bethel, Grand Guardian Council, and Jurisdiction of Job's Daughters International, both present and future.
- (e) Records
 - (1) The Chairman shall keep a permanent file which shall be turned over to her successor.

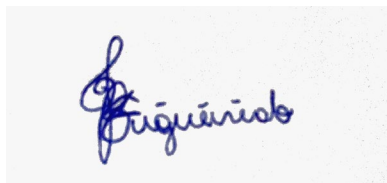
REASON FOR CHANGE:

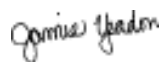
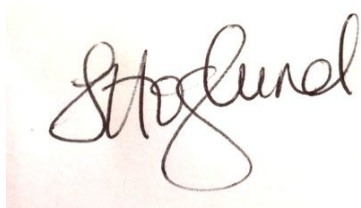
